## What you can recycle



Recycle all of your paper, card, cans, plastic, cartons and glass together in your green wheelie bin or recycling bags or boxes.

Please put out your recycling before 7am on the day of collection, at the edge of your property's boundary, clearly visible from the road.

Remove film lids from plastic pots, punnets and trays

Plastic containers of any size or colour, including:

- Yoghurt pots
- Food trays
- Ice cream tubs
- Margarine containers
- Fruit punnets
- Plastic bags
- Magazine wrapping

#### No thanks...

- Liquid waste
- Food waste (this goes in your food caddy)
- Sweet wrappers and crisp packets
- Nappies
- Plastic toys
- Polystyrene packing or beads
- Food storage containers
- Plastic furniture
- Black sacks, biodegradable and degradable bags

#### Yes please...

Plastic bottles of all kinds, including:

- · Mineral water, cordial and cooking oil bottles
- Milk bottles
- Soft drink bottles

- Bleach and cleaning fluid bottles
- Shampoo and shower gel bottles
- Detergent and fabric conditioner bottles

## **Drink cartons**



#### Yes please...

 Wax-lined, poly-lined and foil-lined cartons (such as milk cartons, Tetra Pak)

#### No thanks...

- Coffee cups
- Liquid waste
- Food waste (this goes in your food caddy)
- Laminated plastic pouches (such as baby food pouches, pet food pouches)

## Mixed paper and cardboard



Flatten cardboard boxes for collection

#### Yes please...

- Newspapers, magazines and catalogues
- Telephone directories / yellow pages
- Envelopes (including windowed)
- Office paper (including coloured paper)
- Wrapping paper
- Junk mail
- Shredded paper
- Cardboard and cereal boxes
- Corrugated card
- Egg boxes
- Greeting cards

#### No thanks...

- Soiled paper/tissue
- Wallpaper
- Waxed paper
- Foil backed card
- Card with padding or bubble wrap

### Metal tins and cans



#### Yes please...

- Drink and food cans (please rinse)
- Aerosol cans (fully emptied)
- Aluminium foil (clean and dry)
- Metal screw tops and bottle tops

#### No thanks...

- Electrical items
- Paint tins
- Any other metals

## Mixed glass bottles and containers



#### Yes please...

- Drinks bottles mixed colours
- Food jars

#### No thanks...

- Pane or toughened glass
- Mirrors/broken glass
- Light bulbs/fluorescent tubes

## Food waste in your caddy



#### Yes please...

- Fruit and vegetables
- Tea bags and coffee grounds
- Bread and pastries
- Dairy products
- Rice, pasta, beans
- Raw and cooked meat, including bones
- Eggs and eggshells
- Cooked and leftover food

#### No thanks...

- Cooking oil
- Food packaging
- Animal waste
- Nappies
- Garden waste
- Any other non-food waste

## You can line your caddy or put food waste straight in.

### Garden waste

- Grass cuttings
- Weeds
- Dead flowers
