2. Be accountable and protect your rights over your data
3. Make sure data is secure, safe and used fairly
4. Make sure data is handled respectfully and only used for the good of our residents
5. Using an outcomes-based way of working will benefit everyone
6. Be clear about how we use your data
7. Protect your rights and privacy
