Orders revoked by this Order

The London Borough of Camden, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 45, 46, 49 and 124 of Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (1984 c. 27) and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order:

1 CITATION, COMMENCEMENT AND REVOCATION

- This Order may be cited as the Camden (Loading Places) Traffic Order 2012 and shall come into force on 1 April 2012.
- Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into force of this Order the Camden (Loading Places) Traffic Order 2011 (2011 No. 49), as amended by the Orders listed in the Annex to this Order, is hereby revoked.

2 INTERPRETATION

- In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:
 - "Act of 1984" means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984
 - "ambulance" means a vehicle that is adapted for, and used for no other purpose than, the carriage of sick, injured or disabled persons to or from welfare centres or places where medical or dental treatment is given and which is readily identifiable as a vehicle used for the carriage of such persons by virtue of being marked 'Ambulance' on both sides
 - "authorised agent" means any contractor which may be appointed by the Council to effect, supervise and enforce the provisions of this Order on its behalf
 - "CA-C permit" means a permit issued under the provisions of the Camden (Parking Places) (CA-C) Traffic Order 2012.
 - "civil enforcement officer" means a person authorised by the Council to supervise any loading place
 - "controlled hours" means the time period indicated in column 4 of each item in the schedules but does not include Christmas Day, Good Friday and any day which is a bank holiday as defined by the Banking and Financial Dealings Act (1971 c. 80)
 - "council" means the Council of the London Borough of Camden and includes any duly authorised officer of the council or contractor
 - "disabled persons' badge" and "relevant position" have the same meanings ascribed to them by the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000 (S.I. 2000 No. 683)
 - "electronic communications apparatus" has the same meaning as in the Communications Act 2003 (2003 c. 21)

- "enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, bylaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment
- "goods" means goods of any kind, whether animate or inanimate, and includes postal packets of any description and "delivering" and "collecting" in relation to any goods includes checking the goods for the purpose of their delivery or collection
- "loading place" means an area on a highway specified in an item in the schedules reserved for the loading or unloading of vehicles, and for the waiting of such vehicles as specified in this Order
- "postal packets" has the same meaning ascribed to it by the Postal Services Act 2000 (2000 c. 26)
- "parking charge", for the purposes of this Order, means a parking charge payable under the provisions of Article 6, 8, 9 or 10 of the Camden (Parking Places) (CA-C) Traffic Order 2011.
- "schedules" refers collectively to Schedules 1, 2 and 3 to this Order
- "traffic sign" has the same meaning as in section 64 of the Act of 1984
- Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
- Any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule shall, unless the context otherwise requires, be construed as a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.
- The Interpretation Act 1978 (1978 c. 30) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- The restrictions, prohibitions and requirements imposed by this Order are in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction, prohibition or requirement imposed by any other enactment and any exception or exemption from the provisions of this Order are without prejudice to the provisions of any other enactment.
- For the purposes of this Order a vehicle shall be deemed to be waiting in a loading place if the vehicle is stationary and any point of the loading place is below the vehicle or its load.

3 DESIGNATION AND USE OF LOADING PLACES

Each area on a highway comprising the length of carriageway specified in **column 3** of the street specified in **column 2** of each item in the **schedules** and having a width throughout of at least 1.8 metres is designated as a loading place.

- During the controlled hours specified in **column 4** of each item in the **schedules**, no driver shall cause any vehicle to wait in a loading place other than whilst goods are being loaded or unloaded onto or from the vehicle or whilst goods are being delivered to or collected from premises in the vicinity of the loading place.
- In the case of any loading place specified in **Schedules 2 and 3**, no driver shall cause any vehicle to wait in a loading place for the purposes of loading or unloading goods or their delivery or collection for a period exceeding 40 minutes unless a longer period has been approved by the Council, a police constable or civil enforcement officer.

4 OTHER PERMITTED WAITING IN LOADING PLACES

- Without prejudice to the provisions of **Article 3**, each loading place specified in **Schedule 2** may be used for the waiting of such vehicles in which is displayed a disabled persons badge in the relevant position in the circumstances specified by Regulation 13 of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 (S.I. 2000 No. 682) between the hours of midnight and 8.30am and between 6.30pm and midnight on Mondays to Saturdays and all day on Sundays.
- Without prejudice to the provisions of **Article 3**, each loading place specified in **Schedule 3** may be used for the waiting of such vehicles in respect of which a parking charge has been paid or in which is clearly display a valid CA-C permit during so that all relevant particulars may be ascertained from the exterior of the vehicle between the hours of midnight and 8.30am and between 6.30pm and midnight on Mondays to Saturdays and all day on Sundays.

5 POWER TO SUSPEND THE USE OF A LOADING PLACE

- The Council or the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis may suspend the use of a loading place or part of a loading place whenever that person considers it reasonably necessary to do so:
- to facilitate the movement of traffic or to promote its safety
- to facilitate any building operation, demolition or excavation adjacent to the loading place
- for the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road and street furniture, the cleansing of gullies or to maintain trees adjacent to the loading place
- to facilitate the laying, erection, alteration, removal or repair in or adjacent to the loading place of any sewer, mains or pipe for the supply of water, gas, electricity or of any electronic communications apparatus
- for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the loading place on any occasion of the removal of furniture to or from a depository, office or dwelling-house adjacent to the loading place
- on any occasion on which it is likely by reason of some special attraction that any street will be thronged or obstructed or to facilitate filming work

- for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the loading place on the occasion of weddings, funerals, or other special occasions
- A police constable in uniform may suspend for not longer than twenty-four hours the use of a loading place or any part thereof whenever he or she considers such suspension reasonably necessary for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety.
- The suspension of a loading place or part of a loading place shall be indicated by the placement in or adjacent to the loading place of traffic signage of such type as may be prescribed or authorised under Section 64 or 65 of the Act of 1984 indicating that the waiting of vehicles is prohibited and the Council may temporarily remove or replace any permanent traffic signage in order to convey the same effect.
- No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to wait in any part of a loading place during such period as there is in or adjacent to that loading place a traffic sign placed in pursuance of **Article 5.3.**
- Nothing in this paragraph shall apply in respect of any vehicle which is waiting for any reason specified in **Article 6.1.1 or 6.1.3** or with the permission of the person suspending the use of all or part of the loading place or a police constable in uniform or any person duly authorised by the Council.

6 RESTRICTION ON WAITING BY A VEHICLE IN A LOADING PLACE

- Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order any vehicle may wait during the permitted hours in any part of a loading place or loading place if the use of that part has not been suspended and if:
- the vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control or to such waiting being necessary in order to avoid an accident or
- the vehicle is an ambulance or is being used for Fire Brigade or Police purposes or
- the vehicle is waiting for only so long as may be necessary to enable it to be used in connection with the removal of any obstruction to traffic or
- the vehicle is waiting for a period not exceeding two minutes or such longer period as a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer may approve to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle or load thereon or unload therefrom their personal luggage but the waiting period shall not be limited if the said person suffers from any disability or injury which seriously impairs their ability to walk or
- the vehicle, not being a passenger vehicle, is being used in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties, provided that in all the circumstances it is reasonably necessary in the exercise of such powers or the performance of such duties for the vehicle to wait in the place in which it is waiting or
- the vehicle is waiting only for so long as may be necessary to enable it to be used in connection with the removal of any obstruction to traffic or

- the vehicle, not being a passenger vehicle, is waiting while postal packets addressed to premises adjacent to the loading place in which the vehicle is waiting are being unloaded from the vehicle, or, having been unloaded therefrom, are being delivered or while postal packets are being collected for loading on the vehicle from premises or posting boxes adjacent to the loading place in which the vehicle is waiting or, having been so collected, are being loaded thereon or
- the vehicle, not being a passenger vehicle, is waiting only for so long as may be reasonably necessary to enable it to be used for any purposes specified in **Articles 5.1.2, 5.1.3 or 5.1.4**.

7 MANNER OF STANDING IN A LOADING PLACE

- Every vehicle left in a loading place which is not in a one-way street shall stand so that every part of the vehicle is within the marked limits of a loading place and with its side parallel to the kerb unless the marked limits of the loading place indicate that the vehicle should stand otherwise.
- In the case of a vehicle left in a loading place that is in a one-way street, the vehicle shall stand so that the nearside of the vehicle is adjacent to the left-hand edge of the carriageway or so that the offside of the vehicle is adjacent to the right-hand edge of the carriageway unless the marked limits of the loading place indicate that the vehicle should stand otherwise.

8 MOVEMENT OF A VEHICLE IN A LOADING PLACE

- Where any vehicle is standing in a loading place in contravention of the provisions of **Article 7** of this Order, a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle in order that its position shall comply with those provisions.
- A police constable in uniform or civil enforcement officer may move or cause to be moved, in case of emergency, to any place he/she thinks fit any vehicle left in a loading place provided that he/she takes such steps as may be reasonable to inform the driver of that vehicle that they have done so.

9 RESTRICTION ON REMOVAL OF PERMITS

Where a CA-C permit has been displayed on a vehicle waiting in a loading place specified in **Schedule 3**, no person, not being the driver or owner of the vehicle, or a person authorised by the Council or its authorised agent shall remove the permit from the vehicle unless authorised to do so by the driver of the vehicle.

10 MANNER OF STANDING IN A LOADING PLACE

- Every vehicle left in a loading place which is not in a one-way street shall stand so that every part of the vehicle is within the marked limits of a loading place and with its side parallel to the kerb unless the marked limits of the loading place indicate that the vehicle should stand otherwise.
- In the case of a vehicle left in a loading place that is in a one-way street, the vehicle shall stand so that the nearside of the vehicle is adjacent to the left-hand edge of the carriageway or so that the offside of the vehicle is adjacent to the right-hand edge of the carriageway unless the marked limits of the loading place indicate that the vehicle should stand otherwise.

11 RESTRICTION ON USE OF A VEHICLE IN A LOADING PLACE

- No person shall use any vehicle while it is in a loading place in connection with the sale of or the attempt to sell any article whatsoever to any person in or near the loading place or offer for hire his skill or services.
- No person shall cause or permit the carrying out of any work of construction or repair of any vehicle in a loading place, except such as may be necessary to enable the vehicle to be removed from the loading place.

12 PLACEMENT OF TRAFFIC SIGNS

- 12.1 The Council shall:
- cause the limits of each loading place to be indicated on the carriageway by placing and maintaining thereon traffic signs
- place and maintain traffic signs in the vicinity of each loading place indicating that the loading place may only be used by such vehicles as specified in **Articles 3 or 4** during the controlled hours
- carry out such other work as is reasonably required for the purpose of the satisfactory operation of a loading place.
